Musician Eyed As Witness

Dr. Lothar Klein, professor of theory and composition in the Department of Music at the University of Texas, is conducting a series of lectures on "The Musician as Witness" at the Episcopal Theological Seminary of the Southwest.

The second in the series of lectures will be Tuesday from 3 to 5 p.m. on "Arnold Schoenberg's Spiritual Journey."

Other topics to be discussed in the following Tuesday afternoon lectures will be "Igor Stravinsky: the True Believer," "The Vision of Saint Augustine," "The 1964 Passion of St. Luke in Poland," and "The Vows of Musical Absurdity."

Dr. Klein has written a number of prize-winning compositions which have been performed throughout the US and in several foreign countries.

The public is invited to the lectures, to be held for the next five Tuesdays from 3 to 5 p.m., which are a part of the Joe L. Crump Lectureships in Theology and Culture at the seminary.
